

Reporting Concerns About a Child in Tower Hamlets

If you are a professional working with children and suspect that a child has been harmed or is at risk of harm in Tower Hamlets, you should notify the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO) within one working day. You can reach the LADO by using Tower Hamlets Connect, and it is advisable to also send a safeguarding alert form via email to enquiry@towerhamletsconnect.org, as recommended by Tower Hamlets. For urgent situations, particularly those classified as Level 4 concerns, please contact the Customer Service Centre at 0345 050 7666.

Out of hours emergency duty team:

If you think a crime has been committed and/or there is an emergency, you should call 999. For non-emergencies call 101.
